- Corrosion-resistant nickel silver screw terminals have high electrical conductivity. Screw terminals give more reliable connections that are less likely to loosen due to vibration.

Installs in panels up to 1" thick. 12V DC, Ignition 5A, Start 5A



M-850 Off-Run-Start

Short bushing: fits panels up to 7/8"
3 terminals. 15A ignition, 20A start, 6-36V DC.



M-832 Off-Run-Start, with Push-to-Choke

Longer bushing: fits panels up to 1 3/8"
6 terminals. 15A ignition, 20A start, 6-36V DC.
